

**Village of Northville Public Bid opening for a new Cold Storage Facility
November 21, 2014**

The Village of Northville (acting Lead Agency) held a public bid opening on Friday, November 21, 2014 at 2:15 p.m. in the Town hall at 412 S. Main St., Northville, NY for proposed erection of a new Cold Storage Facility on Town of Northampton/Village of Northville (old Delia) property at 110 High Rock Road which is situated on the corner of State Highway 30 and High Rock Road, Fulton County in the Town of Northampton.

Present: Supervisor James Groff, Mayor John Spaeth, Darryl Roosa, Village Clerk-Wendy Reu, Town Clerk-Elaine Mihalik, a Representative from D & J Construction and a woman.

Mayor John Spaeth opened the bid packets received for the Cold Storage Shed.

Gallo Construction in Watervliet, NY	\$201,800.00
D & J Construction in St. Johnsville, NY	\$243,518.60

Mayor Spaeth noted that the bids will be reviewed and will be presenting the award forward.

D&J Representative mentioned that there weren't a lot of spec's on this job. You will see that everything was spelled out in the bid packet noting that they were using more high end materials.
