


Figure 66 Architect's rendering of the Adirondack Inn, built in 1891 by the F, J& G Railroad




Figure 67 Tower Inn, now the site of the Grand Union grocery store in Northville




Figure 71 Fish House covered bridge over the Sacandaga River, completed in 1818
