MINUTES: Town Board members present unanimously agreed to waive approval of the Thursday, October 11, 2018 – 2019 Proposed Tentative Budget Work Session meeting minutes and Wednesday, October 17, 2018 – Regular Town Board meeting minutes until the next duly held Town Board meeting.

Supervisor Groff **opened the Public Hearing** at 7:00 p.m. on Local Law #1 of 2018 – Entitled : “A Local Law Authorizing a Property Tax Levy in Excess of the Limit Established in General Municipal Law §3-c.”

Discussion on a new garbage truck

The consensus is that the Village is going to buy a new garbage truck and the Town would help finance it with the money that we would save by Direct Hauling stated the Supervisor. The maximum the Village would finance is \$190,000.00 stated Nathan Matthews. After discussion a motion was made as follows:
