NEW BUSINESS:

Councilman Gritsavage explained this meeting is by the request of Ken Adamczyk, Joint Youth Director. It was explained that Mr. Adamczyk has taken a full-time job and will not spending as much time with the summer recreation program this year as he had hoped. Mr. Adamczyk has asked for an increase in salary or to give a stipend for an additional \$250.00 to Charlotte Albertin who will be increasing her time with the Summer Recreation Youth Program as the Assistant Director.

Will Ken be taking a decrease because he will not be there? What is his hour break-down?

Response His hour break-down is horrendous.

He does a fabulous job that is not the point.

What is over all percentage he does for the program?

It is believed that the Summer Recreation Youth Program consumes approximately 75% of Ken's time. The program is 4 days for 5 weeks. Ken goes above and beyond what he does, like setting up and taking down of the bouncy houses. Trustee Sedon stated that she feels that Charlotte Albertin deserves the \$250.00. She will be in charge for 10 more extra days stated Trustee Eckert. Ken will be at the Summer Program on more critical times stated Mr. Matthews. Even before the program starts he's working on stacks of paperwork. Discussion ensued on the thought of, if there were an increase of registrants. We are always staffed adequately plus stated Mr. Matthews. After discussion a motion was made as follows:
