Per a note provided by Deputy Supervisor/Councilman William Gritsavage to the Town Clerk dated November 30, 2021. Deputy Supervisor/Councilman William Gritsavage explained that it was made necessary for the Town Board to appoint an interim Town Justice because of the resignation of Town Justice Paulette Lewek effective date December 31, 2021. It was so noted that Supervisor James Groff has previously recused himself from the process and had asked Councilman William Gritsavage as Deputy Supervisor to preside over this discussion and vote.

A discussion and a vote had been done via Telephone on November 26, 2021 between Deputy Supervisor/Councilman William Gritsavage and Town Board Members-Councilman Darryl Roosa, Councilman Art Simmons and Councilwoman Molly Zullo.

The vote was 3 to 1 in favor of appointing Attorney Darrin Dietz as interim Town of Northampton Justice starting January 1, 2022 until the next election in November 2022.
